Show accents by using ":" and "`". For example: The Sindarin word "râd" would be written, "ra:d" and the Sindarin prefix "ú-" would be written, "u`".

When using IPA, don't capitalize letters. They tend to stand for other sounds. The capital R, for example, is used to describe a sound found in French and Arabic. I don't mind the capital "D" I suggested using in the place of "ð" if you can't see the symbol; but please don't capitalize the beginnings of the pronunciations!

Separate syllables with dashes, so I can more clearly see your reasoning.

Mark the stressed syllable with an apostrophe before the stressed syllable.

You must have gotten all of the questions correct before you can move onto the next lesson. That way I make certain you understand the material fully enough that you won't be confused in later chapters.
